When are the General Meetings? What is involved?

General Meetings are the first Wednesdays of months October through June. Doors open at 10 a.m. for conversation, meetings start at 10:30 a.m. Lunch tickets are available for \$15 at the door. If you are not interested in having lunch with us, but are attending the meeting, it is \$5. Members are required to attend at least one meeting annually. Meetings include Club business, Chair and Committee updates, fundraising, lunch and a program of specific topics related to the luncheon.

What are the Ways & Means functions and how do I participate?

Members are expected to raise monies for our service activities in the community. When the Committee Chair calls those who have signed up (from their application information), the member is expected to help. Please see the below events for details.

Friendship Soup Mix: This fundraiser requires the creation of the mix by a large group working together; selling the soup at shows requires a small group of individuals selling soup.

Bunco: A fun game night for members and guests! This fundraiser needs members to work on planning, advertising, etc.

Festival of Trees*: Members are needed to decorate artificial holiday trees, sell tickets, do advertising, and to seek business support for prizes. Hosted offsite, this annual event is a great way to bring in the holiday season. Attendees are encouraged to buy raffle tickets for a chance to win one of many beautifully decorated trees. Lunch included with ticketed admission.

Dinner: Event Details. Members are needed to help plan and promote this event.
