When are the General Meetings? What is involved?

General Meetings are the first Wednesdays of months October through June. Doors open at 10 a.m. for conversation, meetings start at 10:30 a.m. Lunch tickets are available for \$15 at the door. If you are not interested in having lunch, but are attending the meeting, it is \$5. Members are required to attend at least one meeting annually. Meetings include Club business, Chair and Committee updates, fundraising, lunch and a program of specific topics related to the luncheon.

What are the Ways & Means functions and how do I participate?

Members are expected to raise monies for our service activities in the community. When the Committee Chair calls those who have signed up (from their application information), the member is expected to help. Please see the below events for details.

Friendship Soup Mix: This fundraiser requires the creation of the mix by a large group working together; selling the soup at shows requires a small group of individuals selling soup.

Bunco: A fun game night for members and guests! This fundraiser needs members to work on planning, advertising, etc.

Festival of Trees*: Members are needed to decorate artificial holiday trees, sell tickets, do advertising, and to seek business support for prizes. Hosted offsite, this annual event is a great way to bring in the holiday season. Attendees are encouraged to buy raffle tickets for a chance to win one of many beautifully decorated trees. Lunch included with ticketed admission.

Dinner: Event Details. Members are needed to help plan and promote this event.

***Major Fundraiser**

What are Sections and how do I join them?

Sections are groups of members who meet to share a common interest. You are welcome to join by attending one of their meetings. See below for meeting days and times. Section Chair information is in your PRTWC Yearbook- you can call them or other members of the Section for details. They would love to have you!

Bookworms: Members who share a common interest in reading meet with this Section once a month to discuss the designated book. Meets 2nd Friday of month, 10 a.m. at the Clubhouse.

Bridgettes: Members enjoy the game of Bridge on the 2nd Wednesday of the month at 10 a.m. at the Clubhouse.

Gourmet: Members meet monthly at local restaurants for delightful dishes and conversation.

Gadabouts: Members venture to places of interest (usually monthly), may ride share and often include lunch together.

Mah Jongg: Meet 2nd and 4th Fridays of the month at 9 a.m. at the Clubhouse.

Bunco: Members meet the 2nd Tuesday of the month at 1 p.m. at the Clubhouse

Theater Buffs: Enjoy outings to movies and local theater productions approximately once a month.

Luncheon Committee Explanation

A luncheon committee is organized monthly to select the luncheon menu, provide appropriate décor, select table linens, and provides the punch. Each member is required to serve on one luncheon committee during the year. The Amenities Chair creates the committees using the information provided on the Membership Application form. If unable to serve on assigned date, the member is responsible for 'swapping' with another member and advising the Amenities Chair of the change (in the event of absence without a substitute, a member will be responsible for a \$20 Hostess fee).
